## Notes for VIOLIN applicants

You are advised to look through the detailed information on the homepage of our microsite before submitting your application.

### Age limit

The age limit for VIOLIN is 27 years old (as at 1 July 2012)

### Application

Your application for VIOLIN must contain the following:

- Application form completed and signed
- Copy of birth certificate or similar official document (ie passport or driving licence) which proves your date and place of birth
- Detailed curriculum vitae / resumé
- Statement of purpose in English (one page maximum) explaining why you wish to participate in the Verbier Festival Academy and what you hope to achieve from participation
- An indication of all chamber music you have played, at what level and how many rehearsals for each work
- Two identical LIVE or unedited CD recordings with three contrasting pieces of music – a movement from a concerto a solo work and any accompanied work.
- DVDs are welcomed – as well as links to online film clips - but these should be sent in addition to, but not instead of, CD recordings.
- One Digital publicity photograph which can be e-mailed to [academy@verbierfestival.com](mailto:academy@verbierfestival.com) or included on a CD-R in your application package.
- Proof of payment of the application fee (see below), or credit card information

### Fee for application

All prospective participants for VIOLIN are required to pay a non-refundable application fee of CHF 100. This is to show your real intention to apply to the Academy and also represents a small contribution to our Administration costs. You can pay in one of two ways:

#### **Credit card** (American Express, MasterCard, Visa)

### **Important dates**

Applications for VIOLIN must be received at the Verbier Festival Academy Office by **27 January 2012** and any application received after the deadline will not be accepted, except in exceptional circumstances.

We will do our very best to make final decisions on acceptance by 10 March 2012. If however you need to have the information earlier, we would ask you kindly to e-mail [academy@verbierfestival.com](mailto:academy@verbierfestival.com) before you accept another invitation.

Accepted violinists should arrive in Verbier on 16 July 2012 and leave on 6 August 2012. We do not allow any Academy participants to arrive late or to leave early.

### **Tuition fee**

For accepted participants, the tuition fee in VIOLIN is CHF 2,500 (approximately EUR 2,000 / US\$ 2,800). However, in cases of genuine financial need, and after being accepted to the Verbier Festival Academy, participants can apply to receive a scholarship in order to take part.
